- o Between 2002-3 and 2004-5 the total OSU faculty salary budget increased from \$52,825,434 to \$55,144,181 -- a 4.4 percent increase.
- o Between 2002-3 and 2004-5 the total faculty salary budget for the rest of the Big 12 increased from \$580,520,447 to \$670,399,563 -- an 15.48 percent increase.
- o Between 2002-3 and 2004-5 the average OSU faculty member's salary rose from \$63,722 to \$67,662 -- a 6.18 percent increase.
- o Between 2002-3 and 2004-5 the average faculty member's salary for the rest of the Big 12 rose from \$73,381 to \$77,279 -- a 5.31 percent increase.
- In 2002-3 it would take \$9,900 to bring faculty in departmental rank groups below the average of the rest of the Big 12 to the rest of the Big 12 average. In 2004-5 this increased to \$10,309 -- a 4.13 percent loss for OSU faculty.
- o 2002-3 the number of faculty in departmental rank groups above the average for the rest of the Big 12 was 44 and those in groups below 785. In 2004-5 this was 50 and 765 respectively.
- O The number of OSU faculty dropped from 829 in 2002-3 to 815 in 2004-5 -- a 1.71 percent decrease. In the rest of the Big 12 the number of faculty grew from 7,911 to 8,675 -- an 9.65 percent increase.
- o In 2002-3 salaries of fourteen OSU departmental ranks were above the average for the rest of the Big 12 -- 9.09 percent of the 154 examined. In 2004-5 this was eleven -- 7.14 percent of the 154 examined.
- Between 2002-3 and 2004-5 the gap between the average for OSU and the rest of the Big 12 was slightly narrowed for Agriculture, Education and Veterinary Medicine and widened for Arts and Sciences, Business, Engineering and Human Environmental Sciences.
- o The salary gap between OSU and the rest of the Big 12 widens with each increase in faculty rank. The greatest gap is at the rank of Professor. These faculty average 84 percent of what similar faculty are paid in the rest of the Big 12.
- O The worst treated groups, compared to the rest of the Big 12 are Professors of Management (67.67%), Associate Professors of Economics (70.08%), Professors of Political Science (70.11%), Professors of Foreign Language (72.24%) and Professors of Statistics (73.18%).
- O The best treated groups, compared to the rest of the Big 12 are Assistant Professors of Hotel & Restaurant Administration (115.19%), Professors of Nutritional Sciences (108.30%), Assistant Professors of Zoology (106.39%), Assistant Professors of Accounting (105.67%) and Assistant Professors of Design, Housing, Merchandising (103.68%)

Overall summary

The number of tenure track faculty have declined with increasing enrollment of students. Faculty salaries are lower than our Big 12 peers and shows a continuing downward trend.

Notes

Oklahoma State University Institutional Research surveys university salaries yearly. The results of their survey are classified into departments equivalent to those at our University. Library faculty are not included. All salaries are standardized to a full time nine month annual salary. Department heads and individual holding endowed chairs are included. Deans and other administrators are not.

Institutional Research provided the list of departments and ranks, the number of OSU and Big 12 faculty at each departmental rank and the mean salaries at each departmental rank for OSU and the Big 12.

The authors calculated the mean salary for the rest of the Big 12 by multiplying the number of OSU faculty at each departmental rank by the mean for that departmental rank and subtracting that from the product of the number of Big 12 faculty at a departmental rank and the Big 12 mean salary for the departmental rank. That, in turn, was divided by the number of Big 12 departmental rank faculty less the number of OSU departmental rank faculty.

The authors calculated the mean OSU departmental rank salary as a percent of that for the rest of the Big 12 by dividing the OSU mean salary by the rest of the Big 12 mean salary and multiplying the result by 100.

The authors calculated the amount needed to bring OSU to the average of the rest of the Big 12 by subtracting the OSU departmental rank mean from that of the rest of the Big 12 and multiplying that difference by the number of OSU faculty. For a few departmental ranks the value was negative, indicating OSU faculty averaged more than their counterparts in the rest of the Big 12. These negative values were not cumulated when calculating college or university totals.
