Goals, Critical Success Factors, and Objectives

Goal One. Library Collection and Services—Offer a larger, more current collection to support OSU-Okmulgee's curriculum.

Critical Success Factors:

- The library will expend \$11,000 \$13,000 on new nursing books
- Distribute an annual survey to OSU-Okmulgee Faculty, assessing the library collection and services. The ultimate goal is to achieve an 80% positive rating
- Weed and replace 5% of our collection annually
- The library holdings will support the new Bachelor of Technology Degrees

Objectives:

Objective 1.1: Build a closer rapport with the OSU-Okmulgee Faculty and their Divisions to help determine titles and material that could be incorporated into the collection.

Strategies:

• The library director will build a closer rapport with faculty and staff by visiting each department on a regular basis, and being attentive to their goals and needs.

Objective 1.2: Inform the OSU-Okmulgee Faculty and Staff of the library collection and services.

Strategies:

• The library staff will communicate by email, phone, and have personal contact with most OSU-Okmulgee Faculty and Staff to inform them of the library collection and services.

Objective 1.3: Build and develop the library collection.

Strategies:

- Purchase additional media shelving for approximately \$2500.00.
- Acquire new shelving for the general collection.
- Acquire new shelving for the reference collection.
- Continue to purchase books and serials in both print and electronically.

Objective 1.4: Create new sources/revenue streams to support library infrastructure, technology, and facilities.

Strategies:

- Establish a "Friends of the Library" non-profit organization.
- Continually search and apply for library grants.

Goal Two. Archive Material—Maintain and preserve the OSU-Okmulgee archive material.

Critical Success Factors:

- Identify a majority of the photographs
- 100% of the photographs will be digitalized
- A complete and accessible archive room
- Professional development

Objectives:

Objective 2.1: Maintaining and preserving our archives.

Strategies:

- Work toward acquiring grants to help maintain and preserve our archive material.
- Attend workshops to further our knowledge of maintaining archives.
- Have a bi-annual gathering to identify photographs.
- Preserve photographs by sorting, identifying, and storing in appropriate boxes.
- Purchase a scanner to transfer all photographs to digital format.

Objective 2.2: Organize to better accommodate access to the archives.

Strategies:

• Create a new archive room that is fully accessible to patrons.

Goal Three. Technology—Pursue state-of-the-art technology designed to assist the students and faculty of our agency.

Critical Success Factors:

- 100% of our computers will be compatible with the computers in the Division labs
- All student computers in the library will be equipped with multimedia capabilities

Objectives:

Objective 3.1: All of the software and hardware on the computers in the library are to be current.

Strategies:

- Collaborate with the OSU-Okmulgee Divisions to provide software and up-to-date technology needed by students.
- Work with Computer Services to keep up-to-date on the latest technology.

Objective 3.2: Improve the OSU-Okmulgee Library homepage.

Strategies:

• Continually improve the OSU-Okmulgee Library homepage by working with the webmaster.

Goal Four. Security—Maintain our collection by acquiring security devices.

Critical Success Factors:

- 90% of our library resources will be secure
- 90% of our collection will be protected by RFID tags

Objectives:

Objective 4.1: Acquire a security system detection unit for the library.

Strategies:

- Acquire a single isle detection unit for the library.
- Acquire RFID tags for circulating material in the library.
- Acquire security cables for our valuable hardware and devices.
- Acquire security cameras for the library.
